

Requirements and conditions to participate in the European Summer School Berlin 2010

1. Social work student

You can participate in the Summer School if you are a student in 2nd, 3rd or 4th year of a bachelor program or of a master program in **social work**.

2. Topic of the Summer School 2010

This year we'll focus on the topic >FIGHT against Human Trafficking< which should attract all students in Eastern and Western Europe due to different reasons. On our website you find an outline of the **preliminary program**.

3. Application deadline

The application deadline is **May 1st, 2010**. On the website you can download the **application form**.

4. Your contribution

As you have seen at the preliminary program we'll probably organise 4 workshops where you have the chance and the duty to present a paper which will be a contribution from your country and your standpoint to the topic of the Summer School.

5. European Credits Transfer System

If you participate in the Summer School which is a recognised module in our study program of social work you will get **3 ECTS**. If you will later send us a paper of your workshop contribution which we can publish on our website then you will get **5 ECTS**.

6. Participation fees

The participation fees are 280 €. For this money you will get in Berlin

- a free bed in the home of a student of our university
- a free ticket for the public transport
- a welcome and farewell party and
- some cultural events in Berlin
